

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
 Between
 THE NATIONAL CREDIT UNION ADMINISTRATION (NCUA)
 And
 THE NATIONAL TREASURY EMPLOYEES UNION (UNION)

In response to NCUA's determination to issue Sprint wireless mobile broadband access cards for Agency issued laptops to all NCUA Examiners not assigned to a regional or Central Office the parties agree to the following.

- 1) Between the dates of December 12 and 14, 2006, the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) will be on site at training in Denver, CO to issue the wireless access cards (including an instruction guide) to any field examiner who elects to participate in the pilot issuance of the cards.
- 2) During the training in Denver, OCIO will man a help desk for examiners to pick up the access cards and receive installation assistance. The help desk will be open at least one-half hour prior to and one-half hour after the conclusion of each days training.
- 3) The examiners electing to participate in this distribution will be allotted up to one hour of computer administration time (code 31) to complete the installation of the access cards on the Agency issued laptops.
- 4) Examiners receiving the wireless access cards will continue to receive up to \$50 communication allowance to reimburse home broadband access for the duration of the pilot program.
- 5) Participating examiners who need assistance from OCIO's help desk will continue to charge that time to computer administration time (code 31).
- 6) This agreement will expire at the end of the mobile broadband access card pilot distribution program, when OCIO distributes the new access cards to all field examiners.
